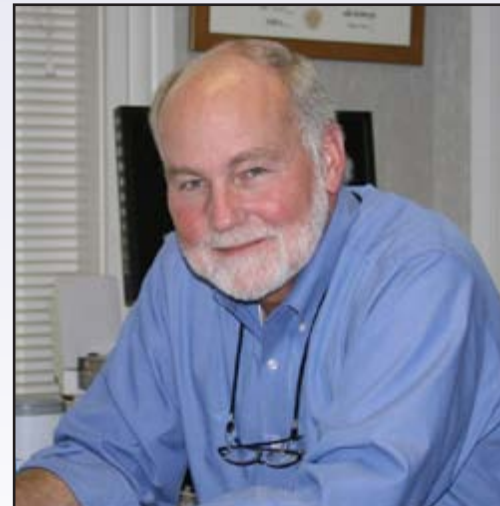

### SEEDS OF FRIENDSHIP

In The Patch art room we often do projects as a group, but staff members do give opportunities for some of the kids to do projects of their own design as well.

One of those students, an 8 year-old girl, wanted to grow some old bird seed she found in the supply closet because she was excited for spring to start. Staff members told her the seed would not grow, because it was an old bag of bird seed, but despite that fact, she was determined to try.

Each day she would dutifully water the pots of dirt, hoping to see green shoots sprouting, but nothing ever grew. Despite her teacher's insistence that she shouldn't place too much hope in this unlikely botanical venture, over time she began to despair, because she didn't see anything growing.



After a week of this, one of the older girls in the room got the spectacular idea to create an arrangement of fake flowers for her to take home, so she got to work with pipe cleaners, paper, and hot glue. When the 8 year-old girl returned to the art room, she saw that something was finally in the pot she had been caring for. The younger girl and the older girl chatted away for the next 10 minutes, and shared a heart-felt hug, proving that although plants can't blossom from old birdseed, sometimes friendships can.

**According to the Pew Research Center,** "Parents with higher income and education are more likely to report that their children participate in various extracurricular activities. Among parents with an annual family income of \$75,000 or higher, 84% say their children participated in sports or athletic activities in the 12 months prior to the survey; 62% say their children took music, dance or art lessons. By contrast, only 59% of parents with annual incomes of less than \$30,000 say their children participated in sports, and 41% say their children took lessons in music, dance or art over that period.

A similar pattern is evident across education groups, with college graduates more likely than those with some college or with a high school diploma or less to say their children have participated in extracurricular activities. For example, about eight-in-ten (83%) parents with a bachelor's degree say their children participated in sports or athletic activities in the year prior to the survey, and 66% say that their children took music, dance or art lessons. Among parents with a high school education or less, the shares are 63% and 42%, respectively."

## TEACHING COMPASSION

"That's not fair!" The group whined to the "security guard" in front of Holladay Hall. "You can't stop us at the border and force us to pay money just because we're carrying a Bible!" The kids were in the middle of a simulation organized by our interns, illustrating some of the prior experiences of refugee families now living in America.

During Refugee/Immigrant week, they heard from local immigrant children, engaged with videos from Amnesty International, and used their social studies skills to research places around the world where there are current refugee crises. The week culminated with the simulation game, designed by the United Nations Commission on Refugees, to teach young children about escaping one country and moving to another. The kids worked in family groups to fill backpacks with necessary supplies, traded their supplies and play money for safe passage, and came to understand the dangers of being an ethnic or religious minority in other countries. They ended the simulation by writing letters to children in other countries through UNICEF. "I can't believe how horrible and stressful it must be for people who really make this journey," said Mariah\*, age 13. "I hope I can help those people one day. We're really lucky to live in America!"

The Patch's Educational Opportunities department engages children with learning activities that inspire them to work toward a bright future. Our staff's innovative teaching techniques spark curiosity and make children excited to learn. Academic achievement is supported by compassionate messages that motivate young people to use their God-given gifts to make the world a better place. We are blessed to invest in their success!

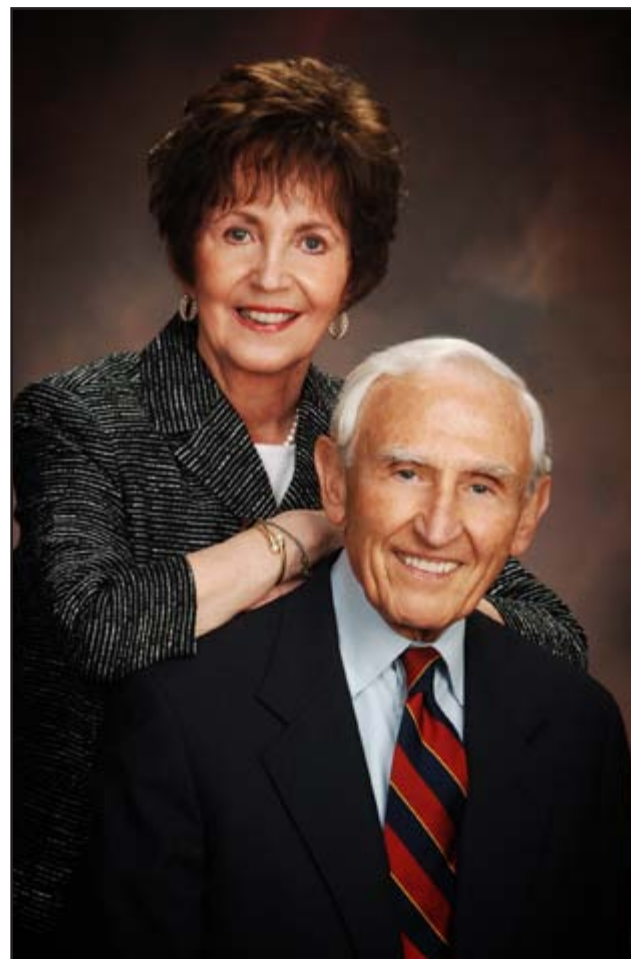

The story of Helen Dillon Mazzoli and her husband, The Honorable Romano ("Ron") L. Mazzoli is a 52 year love story filled with enough joy to span generations. Moved to share that joy with at-risk children of Louisville, Congressman Mazzoli established the Helen Dillon Mazzoli Overall Mission Endowment Fund in memory of his beloved wife so that young people could experience creativity, learning and personal growth. Helen's legacy lives in the accomplishments of these young people who dare to transcend difficult circumstances.

Among Helen's many talents was dance, and she danced all the way through her life, bringing grace and precision to her roles in public service, education and motherhood. As a teacher, she conducted lessons at home for her own children in addition to conducting classes at Sacred Heart Academy and the Ellen Erma Flanedy Dance Studio. As a public servant, she supported her husband's campaigns and political terms, including his 24-year period representing Kentucky's Third Congressional District in the United States House of Representatives. Her most beloved role was that of mother and grandmother. She made Christian love the heart of her family life, and served as an active member of Our Mother of Sorrows parish.

Throughout their lives, Ron and Helen prayed together for guidance. Ron notes that in today's busy world, many find it hard to reserve time for prayer, but The Patch always does. He admires the way the organization seeks the Lord's direction while improving troubled lives.

"The Patch takes lives that are broken and battered and reclaims them," he says. "People who have been turned away by society, they re-mold them like Michelangelo would mold a piece of clay into David or the Pieta."

The funds provided by the Helen Dillon Mazzoli Overall Mission Endowment Fund empower The Cabbage Patch to continue to create masterpieces from the potential of at-risk children and families. We are grateful for the legacy of opportunity that was created from Helen's beautiful life.

**PROVIDING A SAFE HAVEN**

"Deshonna" is a single parent with a daughter who benefits from the recreation and educational programs offered for at-risk youth at The Patch. Deshonna is a student at JCTC and works full-time for the Health Department, but her hourly wage is still \$10 lower than a living wage for a single parent. However, her wages are too high to qualify for programs such as SNAP (i.e. "Food Stamps").

Recently, she called our Family Services department in order to ask if she was eligible to receive some financial assistance for her LG&E bill. After the phone call, our Family Services Specialist got curious about what crime was like in her neighborhood so he plugged in her address on the police department's crime mapping website.

In a 6-day period of time, within ½ mile of her home, there were 8 drug offenses, two harassment and assault charges, one possession of a handgun by a convicted felon and two automobile break-ins.

The Cabbage Patch provides a safe haven for families living in troubled neighborhoods. The resources that you help provide when you support The Patch are essential to improving the quality of life. Parents like Deshonna are grateful that you sympathize with their challenges and provide them with a place of hope.

## ALUMNUS SPOTLIGHT:

### MAJOR VERNON W. WOLFORK IV



Before Major Vernon W. Wolfork IV became a decorated military officer, he was a kid at The Cabbage Patch, enjoying camping and canoeing along with all of the other character-building programs offered. Vernon was a regular in the Leadership Development program, and true to its name, the program helped him learn to become a leader. His first job was in The Patch's Fun Club, and he has fond memories of the mentorship offered by Mr. Chin and Mr. Napier. When Vernon graduated from high school in 1997, he continued to volunteer at The Patch and serve as a role model for the next generation of children.

Vernon's life after The Patch has been full of accomplishments. He enlisted in the Army after high school and was deployed to Bosnia in 1999. Upon his return, he attended Western Kentucky University before transferring to the University of Louisville, where he graduated with a Bachelor of Science and received an ROTC commission in 2004. His military achievements include leading his unit through mobilization and deployment to Iraq in 2011, earning the Military Outstanding Volunteer Service Medal, two Army Commendation Medals, the Bronze Star, the Meritorious Unit Citation and a Combat Action Badge. His most recent promotion, to the rank of Major, took place in 2016.

Vernon and his wife Tiffany met during his studies at Western Kentucky University, and they married in 2003. They are the proud parents of three boys. Vernon now has the opportunity to pass on the values that he learned at The Patch to his own children, just as he did for The Patch kids when he volunteered for our programs years ago.



## VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT:

### LARRY CASHEN

Children who are outstanding participants in our Safe Urban Biking program are rewarded with invitations to participate in our 100-mile biking and camping trips! These excursions are life-changing opportunities for urban youth to experience nature and see historically significant sites. With these trips, children sign up for fun, but they are prepared to handle challenges. They know how to repair their bikes, what to do in case of inclement weather and how to help their fellow travelers accomplish their goals.



Cabbage Patch Board member and volunteer Larry Cashen is one of the group leaders who exemplifies the values of teamwork and perseverance during the bike travel adventures. In the summer of 2016, Larry led a group of young bikers through a trail riddled with storm damage. As he navigated downed trees and other debris, he helped children lift their bikes over obstacles while keeping them calm and focused! He showed the children through his actions that when you have tenacity and overcome your worries, you can accomplish any goal.

Larry says:

"Serving on The Cabbage Patch board is an honor. The Patch is all about the kids; it exists to serve. And I think it is important to try to actually connect with the kids. For me the easiest way is to go on the bike camping trip to D.C. or a weekend at Tim Horton camp. Those events require you to mix it up with the kids."

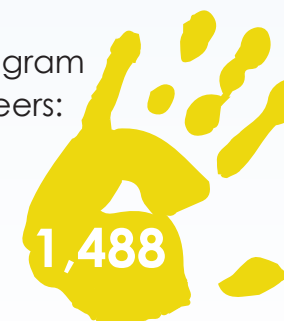

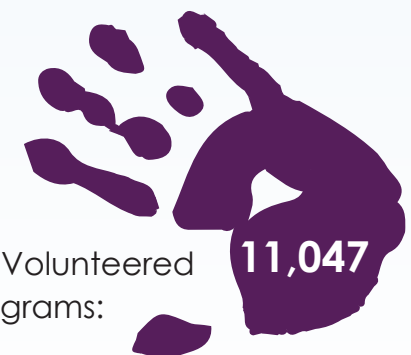

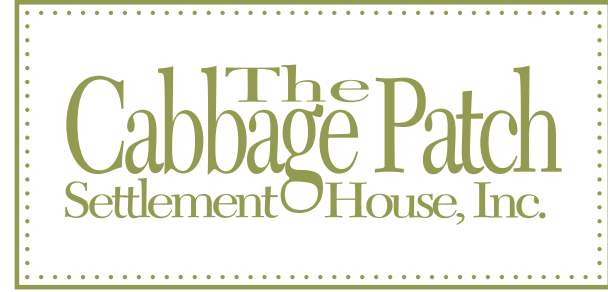
Total Program Volunteers:

## Our Mission:

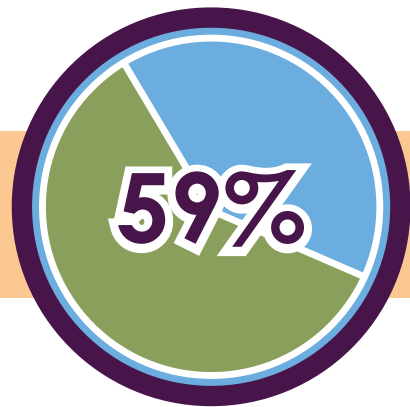

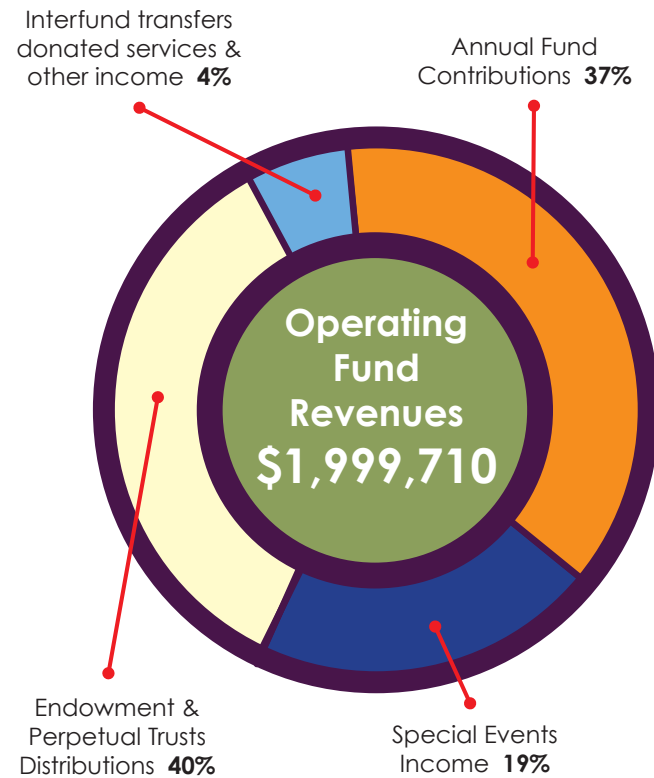

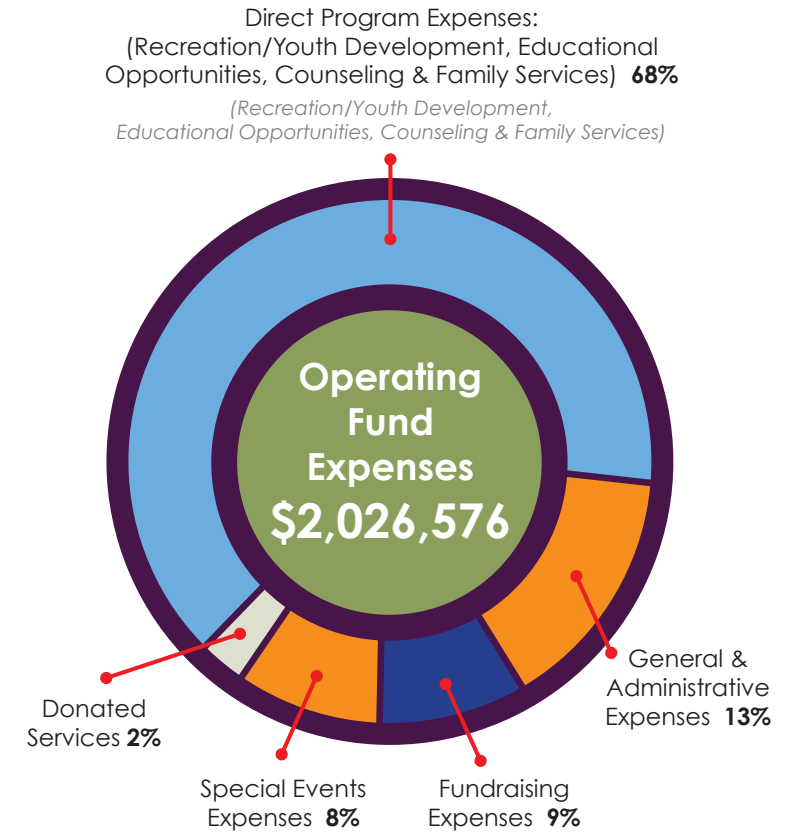

Total Assets at April 30, 2016 were \$23,705,454 (including \$5,777,680 in Property & Equipment [net of depreciation] and \$17,311,281 in Endowments/Investments/Perpetual Trusts.) Total net revenue for all funds for the fiscal year ended April 30, 2016 was \$1,008,074 (Annual fund revenues of \$1,999,710; Contributions to endowments & property funds of \$203,102; Net endowment/perpetual trusts investment income/gains [losses] of [\$1,189,557] and other revenues [expenses] of [\$5,181]).

Total expenses for all funds for the fiscal year ended April 30, 2016 was \$2,293,762 including Depreciation expense of \$257,357.

The Cabbage Patch is a BBB Accredited Charity meeting all 20 Standards for Charity Accountability and adheres to Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP). The Patch has a 4-star rating from Charity Navigator.

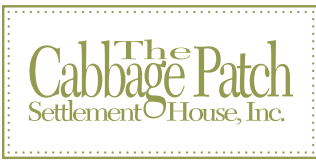
